Hiring Nepali workers for Europe? This checklist covers what to verify in any agency before you sign a demand letter: DOFE licence status, Europe corridor experience, trade-test capability, fee transparency (zero-cost-to-worker rule), and demand-letter processing track record. Use the comparison table below, then request references from two recent Europe placements.

Agency Comparison - What to Check (2026)

Criteria	What "Good" Looks Like	Red Flag
DOFE licence	Active licence verifiable on dofe.gov.np ; number matches company name	No licence number offered, or number not found
Europe experience	Recent Romania/Poland/Croatia placements with named references	Only Gulf experience, no EU corridor proof
Worker fees	Zero cost to worker (Free Visa Free Ticket rule applies)	Charges worker for visa, ticket or "training"
Trade testing	Filmed practical trade tests; certification dossiers (CTEVT/NSDA)	CVs only, no test evidence
Contract terms	Bilingual EN/NE contract with salary, food, accommodation, leave	English-only or verbal terms
Communication	Named contact reachable on WhatsApp/Viber through the contract terms	Disappears after payment
After-placement	Handles renewals, replacements, document renewals	No support after deployment

How to Shortlist the Top 10 (Method)

1. Pull the DOFE licensed-agency list (dofe.gov.np) and filter for agencies with active Europe demand letters.
2. Cross-check each agency against the criteria table above - score 1 point per criterion met.
3. Request two employer references for Romania or Poland placements in the last 12 months.
4. Ask for the filmed trade test of one candidate per role you need (this is the strongest quality signal).
5. Confirm the fee structure in writing: worker pays nothing; employer covers visa, ticket and processing.
6. Verify the agency's demand-letter track record for your destination (embassy attestation experience matters).
7. Check the physical Kathmandu office (visit or video call) before transferring any funds.
